

The Charlton Heights Building Council met on Wednesday, March 16, from 3:20 p.m. to 4:20 p.m. in the Library Media Center. The minutes of the meeting are below:

1. An update was given on the BH-BL Budget process for the upcoming May election. More information can be found on the district website, and by attending the community forum, scheduled for March 29 at 7:30 p.m. at the Middle School.
2. The Building Council members discussed the summer math challenge. A flyer will be distributed with log in information and student passwords. The math questions for grades 1 and 2 will be simplified. For awards, a larger medal will be given to students who complete both the reading and math challenge. A special ribbon will be given if a child completes one or the other challenges, and a participation ribbon. Teachers will be asked to put information about the summer challenge in their supply letter to families. The participation sheets for the summer reading challenge will be due on the first Friday of the first full week of school. Winners will be announced at an assembly in September.
3. The theme of "Healthy Choices" will be featured at our annual Walk About on April 28. Staff members and students will be asked to decorate using this positive theme.

The next Building Council meeting will be on April 6. Agenda items will be an update on grade level goals, and a discussion of our May healthy choice fitness activity.
