1. Summer Math Challenge: Grades 1 and 2 will have revised problems this year. User names and a password database will be given to Andy so that parents will know how to log in to the program this year. A sticker with this information will be placed on the report card. Teachers will be asked to staple the Summer Reading and Math brochure to the 4th quarter report card.
