

Minutes of the CH Building Council meeting on September 21, 2011

1. The shared decision making guidelines were reviewed.
2. Possible goals for next year were discussed. It was decided that teams at Charlton Heights will determine an area of focus in either language arts, mathematics, or both. Each grade level will be given the responsibility of creating a SMART goal based on the language arts or mathematics data collected. Some possible ways of measuring achievement are running records, state assessments and district assessments.
