The meeting was called to order by the Clerk of the Board Jackie St. Onge at 7:30 P.M.

Clerk of the Board Jackie St. Onge administered the Oath of Allegiance to re-elected Board Members Elizabeth Herkenham & Patre Kuziak and newly elected Board member James Maughan.

Clerk of the Board Jackie St. Onge appointed Joe Pericone as temporary chairman.

Temporary Chairman Joe Pericone requested nominations for position of President. Joe Pericone was nominated by Elizabeth Herkenham. Nomination was seconded by Patre Kuziak. No further nominations were received. Mr. Pericone was elected President by a vote of 4-0.

Elizabeth Herkenham nominated John Blowers as Vice-President of the Board, seconded by Patre Kuziak. No further nominations were received. John Blowers was elected Vice-President by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Pericone assumed chairmanship of the meeting and presided with the following business:

Ms. Herkenham moved and Ms. Kuziak seconded that the following institutions or individuals be designated to perform specific functions as required by law:

It is recommended that Jim Schultz, Superintendent of Schools be designated as representative to make application for and receive federal funds on behalf of the school district and that Assurances of Compliance for Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.

It is recommended that Amy Baluch, Human Resources Director be designated as the official to assure compliance with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and as privacy official under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

It is recommended that Sharon McTygue, Special Services Director be appointed as district representative under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

It is recommended that Jacqueline St. Onge, Assistant Superintendent for Support Services be designated as Records Access Officer under the Freedom of Information Law (FOIL).

It is recommended that Jim Schultz, Superintendent of Schools, or his designee, be authorized to act as hearing officer in any hearing of charges against a Civil Service employee under the provisions of Paragraph 3, Section 75 of the New York State Civil Service Law, as amended.

It is recommended that Jacqueline St. Onge, Assistant Superintendent for Support Services, and Theresa Barclay, Business Administrator be appointed as purchasing agents in accordance with Section 170.2 (b) of Commissioner's Regulations.

It is recommended that David Martin, District Supervisor of Custodians be appointed as the district's Designated Person to monitor asbestos activities and ensure compliance with rules established in federal AHERA legislation.

It is recommended that Jim Schultz, Superintendent of Schools be appointed as the district's Designated Person to verify payrolls in compliance with Section 170.2(b) of Commissioner's Regulations.

It is recommended that Jim Schultz, Superintendent of Schools, be authorized to approve budget appropriation transfers during the year as permitted by Section 170.2 of Commissioner's Regulations.

It is recommended that the Bank of America be designated as the district depository for the General Fund and Trust and Agency Funds. It is further recommended that the Ballston Spa National Bank be designated as the district depository for the Extra Classroom Activity Fund and School Lunch Funds and the JP Morgan Bank, New York, as the depository for Capital, Debt Service, Insurance Reserve, Special Aid and trust and Agency Funds, not a subsidiary portion of the General Fund.

It is recommended that the following financial institutions be authorized by the Board in compliance with the guidelines of Policy 3230 (Investment of Surplus Cash) as institutions through which surplus District funds may be invested.

- g) Cooperative Liquid Assets Securities System (CLASS)
- h) Morgan Stanley, Boston, Mass.
- i) Bank of America Investments, Albany, NY

It is recommended that the *Daily Gazette* be designated as the official newspaper of the district for the publication of required legal notices.

It is recommended that approved business mileage be reimbursed for the 2009-2010 school year at the IRS rate.
