Dear Third Grade Families:

Welcome to third grade! There are some items that you will need for virtual school. If you already have access to these items at home, you will not need to purchase a separate set just for school. Please keep in mind, as the year progresses, you may need to supplement additional supplies that are easily consumable.

Supply List

- Colored pencils—one box of 12 or 24 count
- Pack of Markers-basic colors are fine (thick or thin whichever you prefer)
- Crayons- 24 count box
- 1 pair of student scissors
- a 12 inch standard ruler
- 3-4 larger sized glue sticks
- one highlighter any color
- one package of 3 x 3 sticky notes
- **2-3 dozen** number two pencils with erasers—plain, yellow Ticonderoga pencils sharpen the best and last the longest
- some type of pencil case or container to hold all the supplies
- 2 wide ruled composition notebooks (can be different colors or designs)
- a supply of unlined white paper, 8.5 x 11 inches (for drawing, scrap paper, etc)
- 3 two pocket folders-one yellow, one green and a third any color or design
- headphones or earbuds for use with the Chromebook (Google Meets, video lessons etc.)
- 9 x 12 inch (or similar size) dry erase board, dry erase marker(s) and something to erase with (old sock, tissues or eraser) **OR** a few clear, report covers/report pockets with a piece of white paper in it can also be used like a dry erase board with a dry erase marker

During virtual learning in the spring, many students found it helpful to identify a specific workspace at home. It should be in a quiet area and away from distractions. The student should have access to a table or desk to set the computer on and a comfortable seat. All your child's supplies should be in this designated area for easy access.

I am excited to get to know each of you, and hear about adventurous, mysterious, or humorous books that you've read over the summer. Please practice your addition and subtraction facts to keep your math skills fresh. I will see you soon! Thank you for preparing all of your supplies.
