Many individuals with disabilities rely on various means tested entitlements to support themselves in the community. Many also need assistance making financial and other important life decisions. One of the most effective tools for providing financial management and ensuring benefit eligibility for individuals with disabilities is the "Supplemental" or "Special" Needs Trust. In this program you will learn:

- 1. The difference between an Agent, Guardian, Trustee and Representative Payee;
- 2. The different standards of capacity for each;
- 3. The importance of having a Will;
- 4. Basic financial eligibility for government benefits;
- 5. The different types of Supplemental (Special) Needs Trusts that are used to help support individuals with disabilities in the community.

Ed Wilcenski is an attorney who concentrates his practice in the areas of guardianship, trusts, and estate planning for individuals with disabilities and their families. He is the brother of a successful and extremely capable man with a developmental disability.
