

O'Rourke's Opinion - Tests & Quizzes



Recently, a survey was sent out to all of the middle school on student's opinions on tests and quizzes. Here are the results.

33.1% of students get stressed out over tests/quizzes. 18.2% of students don't get stressed out over tests/quizzes. The other 48.7% of students only sometimes get stressed out.

There were quite a few different responses for how long students spend studying, but the most common response was 30 minutes of studying with 20 minutes and more than 40 minutes close behind.

More than 50% of students said that their least favorite subject to take a test or quiz in was math. More than 25% of students said that their favorite subject to take a test or quiz in was social studies with language test and quizzes in close behind.
